



Frequently Asked Questions 2010 JTS Electrics Just4Kids Motor Trail The Cape York Safari – 20-31 August 2120 (12 days) (as at 12 November 2009)

WHAT IS MY INVESTMENT, WHAT DO I NEED TO DO, HOW DO I DO IT?

- \$500.00 entry fee per vehicle (entry form available at www.just4kidsmotortrail.com.au)
Plus \$30 for Jardine River Ferry and NPA permits. Total - \$530 payable on registration
- \$1,000.00 tax deductible donation per person (adult 17 yrs and over) travelling in the entered vehicle. 3 or more adults travelling in same vehicle, maximum donation payable \$3,000.

- Accommodation will be varied for the Cape York Safari. Just4Kids will reserve rooms and camp sites that will be payable by entrants. You will need to confirm your booking direct from the J4K accommodation list supplied at the time of registration. Shared camping and accommodation will also be available with other J4K entrants and there will be occasions on the Cape York trip that camping is the only option.
- \$800.00 per adult for all meals, and functions for twelve days including the gala dinner on the last night.
- Children – 0-6 years meals, events, functions - FOC
7-11 years - \$120.00 per head (if travelling with family)
12-16 years - \$400 per head (if travelling with family)
17 and over – full adult price (\$800.00 per head)
A rate for families of 2 Adults + 3 children or more will be considered on an individual basis.
- Fuel for vehicle is payable by entrants.
- Paronella Park, Split Rock Art tour, Thursday Island ferry are part of surveyed route – Total for Adults - \$150 per person. Children 5-14 yrs - \$75.00 per child. If you hold a Pension Concession card please let us know as the Thursday Island ferry will be at a reduced price for you.

What is the tax-deductible donation used for?

This money is presented to the disabled and disadvantaged children or their respective organisations along the Just4Kids Motor Trail.

Additional funds are distributed throughout the year to Just4Kids projects and through the Just4Kids Youth Support Program

Can my entry and other associated costs be sponsored by an organisation?

Yes, you can obtain sponsorship for your entry and costs if you wish, the majority of entrants do. The \$1,000 donation per person is 100% tax deductible. Details about Just4Kids and their charity status and registration forms are available on the website.

Do I need a four wheel drive?

The route is only suitable for 4x4 or high clearance all wheel drive vehicles. However if you choose the main Development road after Weipa rather than the Telegraph Track and your car has been prepared so it can handle the Cape Roads and you have adequate knowledge, skills and support to maintain your vehicle with your team, well prepared cars can enter the Event after discussing with the Motortrail Director. All entrants intending to do the Telegraph Track will need specific set ups for their vehicle. Please obtain a copy of the "TJM recommended compulsory and suggested items" for your trip, by downloading the list from our TJM Cape York vehicle requirements link. All vehicles will be scrutinised prior to the Event's departure date and will need to pass this requirement before starting the Motor Trail.

Please check with the Motor Trail Director, Mark Louez, well in advance about the circuit conditions Ph: 0747 59 1450. Keep in mind that conditions may vary from the official survey date. There will be an option on this Motor Trail to do the Telegraph Track, or take an alternative road, to the top. Any person intending to do the Telegraph Track will need to be experienced in 4x4 driving. For any person wanting to do a 4x4 driving course prior to our 2010 Event, please contact Dave Darmody, P7, through our website. Dave is a licensed off road driving instructor and is familiar with our requirements.

Can entrants dress in a theme, as well as decorate their vehicle?

Yes, as we will be visiting schools and large groups of children, a theme for your entry is encouraged and POINTS are awarded for the most innovative themes.

Do I have to provide my own meals and arrange accommodation along the way?

No, this is organised by the volunteer committee and all meals are part of your entry costs (please see above).

If you have special dietary needs arrangements will be put in place to manage your requirements. You will receive a form for this on registration which must be filled out and all personal information is held in a sealed envelope by our medic.

All you will need to do is just relax, have fun and enjoy the day in the country. Your accommodation will be pre organised and a list sent to you upon receipt of your entry form and the \$500 car entry. It is up to the individual entrants to book and pay for their own accommodation using this list.

You can travel with an off road 4x4 campervan if you wish to reduce your costs. You can also tow a camp trailer, just keep in mind that the roads can be very corrugated and any trailers will need to be in good condition. All towns we are visiting have camping grounds and/or caravan

parks. If road conditions change it may prevent off road campervans from travelling on the Just4Kids surveyed route. The Motor Trail Director will advise well in advance as Just4Kids has a scout team to check conditions each day.

Will there be mobile phone coverage in the towns we are visiting?

Your digital phone will be limited in its coverage in the Cape York area

The Telstra Next G during the survey had coverage in some areas including Bamaga and Thursday Island but not Seisia. Telstra pay phones are available. A phone card and coins are recommended.

Just4Kids Satellite Phone 24/7 numbers to receive or send a message will be issued at a later date.

A list of all overnight stops, with the address and phone number of the Motels and Caravan/camping Parks will be provided.

Officials will have satellite phones if you need to make an emergency call from a remote area.

Is there support if my vehicle breaks down?

Yes, there are service crews to assist you if you break down.

Driving to the conditions of the road makes for a trouble free event.

Can Just4Kids assist me with my fundraising?

Just4Kids has a variety of concepts to help you raise funds.

When do I have to get my entry registration and associated payments in by?

An expression of interest is desirable ASAP as numbers will be limited. We suggest you pay your car entry (\$500) and NPA permit fee (\$30) as a deposit to secure your position and finalise your total payment by 30th June 2010 to obtain the tax benefit.

Numbers are limited for 2010 due to special locations, EPA restrictions and logistics for catering. PLEASE book NOW to avoid disappointment!

Can I make split Payments?

YES, Just4Kids can bill you Monthly or you can pay via Credit Card.

The car entry of \$530 is required to reserve your place and your preferred vehicle number. As soon as the \$530 is received we will issue the accommodation list. To take advantage of the 2009/10 tax period we suggest you pay the per person donation in full by 30th of June 2010. The per person entry donation fee being \$1,000 is 100% claimable as a Charity donation.

How many other cars will be participating in Just4Kids Great Australian Motor Trail?

The 2010 Just4Kids Motor Trail is set at 30 units plus officials.
